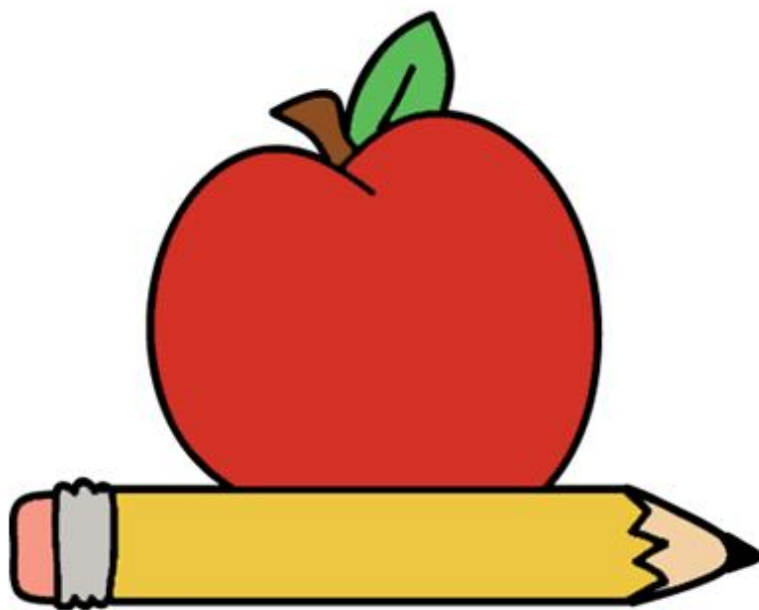

Today let us do a review counting! How high can you count? Start a math journal. Everyday practice writing your numbers adding 5 new numbers each week! Today write up to the number five!

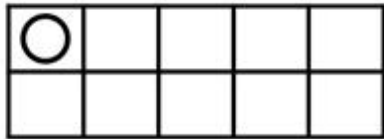
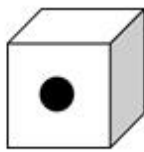

It can also help us learn to add and subtract! Let's begin!

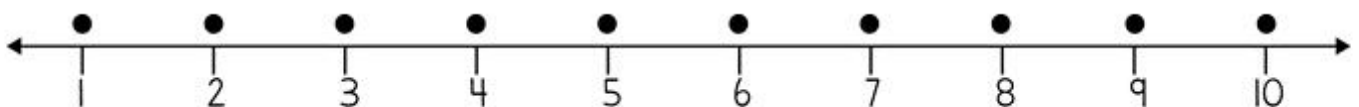
